## IV. Agency Spotlight: Sami Slusser & Heather Charlesworth

- C21 Afterschool
  - Currently have 11 sites around Adams County with the goal to increase math, language, and science scores for the children in the program.
  - Andrea is writing for the next round of C21 grants that could bring back 21 schools. Unfortunately, 5 separate applications must be submitted so we will be competing with ourselves. Won't know until February/March what the results are.
  - The afterschool program is critical for families with agricultural/ working parents.
  - Currently, the program runs for 3 hours Monday through Thursday.
    The new funding requires the program to run for 5 days a week.
  - o There is no funding available for a summer program in 2024.
  - A big problem in Adams County is the lack of childcare options.
    Currently, there are more childcare vouchers available than matching childcare seats.
